- Develop, implement and administer accounting procedures and systems for SWAT Ministry International (SWAT);
- Maintain responsibility for the proper accounting and financial practices in all SWAT projects, funding nations, individual donors, and daily income and expenditures;
- Produce financial reports at the request of the Leadership Team;
- Maintain contact with all accountants and financial specialist in each funding nation as we grow;
- Advise the Leadership Team (strategically) about all relevant financial matters;
- Update the Leadership Team and the Board with monthly financial statements;
- Produce the Annual Accounts Report and liaise with the auditor in the production of annual audited accounts;
- Ensure that SWAT uses best practice in accounting and other financial matters as well as in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations in their countries of residence;
- Contribute to strategic planning and development as a member of the Management Team; and
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Leadership Team.
